2010 Election of Directors

Applications for Director positions/vacancies are solicited through an open call to all SEAA members in good standing. In accordance with our bylaws, we will prepare an electronic notice addressed to the designated voting representative for each member company giving notice of the election and deadlines. This notice will be posted on the Association's website at www.seaa.net, whereby the Nomination By Petition application may be downloaded and printed. ([pdf](#)).

Nominations by Petition must be received no later than Monday, **January 21, 2010**, and sent to the attention of: Elections Department c/o Steel Erectors Association of America, 2216 West Meadowview Road, Suite #115, Greensboro, NC 27407.

Then, not later than forty-five days (45) days prior to the annual meeting (March 13, 2010) the SEAA office will mail an acceptable proxy form and a ballot listing the names of all applicable nominees and the election deadline, as submitted by the Nominating Committee ([Board-Endorsed Slate](#)), and by members' petition, to the voting membership for vote.

The Association Executive Director and an independent auditor shall check each ballot returned against the roster of voting members in good standing and shall count and tabulate the ballots and prepare a written report on the results for presentation to the Board, together with all ballots received, for certification at the next Board meeting. Ballots must be received no later than 30 days prior to the annual meeting of members in order to be validated and accepted. Said ballots must include member's company name and authorized signature to be considered valid.
